Admission requirements for nursing major: 1) *Pre-requisites/co-requisites must be completed with at least a C grade; 2) For PS 101, PS 124, SO 122, & CO 101, two of the four must be complete prior to admission 3) Cumulative GPA of 3.0; 4) Completion of Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) course by first day of Year Two; 5) BI 125, BI 273, BI 150 & CH 110 can be repeated once only; 6) Transfer credit must be sent to MMU by end of spring term of the year applying to the major; 7) Prerequisites must be completed by the end of spring term of the year applying to the major. Applicants with summer courses remaining (except CNA) will be on waitlist. 8) Immunization record and Health Physical must be submitted with the application to major paperwork.
