YOUR NEXT STEPS CHECKLIST

- SUBMIT YOUR ENROLLMENT DEPOSIT**
\$200 saves your spot in the incoming class. Return the enclosed form or deposit online at mtmercy.edu/deposit. The deposit is applied to your student account.
- COMPLETE YOUR HOUSING APPLICATION**
If living on campus, please submit your housing form online at mtmercy.edu/housing. There is no separate housing deposit. If you need a paper copy of the housing form, please call the admission office.
- FILE THE FAFSA**
To apply for state and federal aid (grants and loans), please submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). More information at fafsa.ed.gov or contact our Financial Aid Office at 319-368-6467. Mount Mercy's FAFSA Code is **001880**.
- SIGN UP FOR REGISTRATION DAY**
Registration Days give you the opportunity to meet fellow classmates and your advisor, and register for classes. **Registration Days occur throughout the year based on your start term.** See mtmercy.edu/registration for dates and more information. *You must submit your enrollment deposit prior to registering for classes.*
- RETURN YOUR FINANCIAL AID AWARD**
Be sure to sign your financial aid award and return to us. Sometimes other documents are required. Go to netpartner.mtmercy.edu/student to see your award and other required documents.
- SEND US YOUR FINAL TRANSCRIPTS**
Request final transcripts for any college coursework you've completed since your admission to MMU. Please send to us prior to attending Registration Day.

OTHER HELPFUL STEPS

Arrange a **tour of campus** with a current student at mtmercy.edu/visit.

Meet with an admissions or financial aid counselor to **discuss scholarship opportunities** and search for outside scholarships (through your school, church, employer, online, etc.).

Meet with a faculty advisor to **learn specific information about academic programs**.

Talk with current and former students to **hear about student life and outcomes**.

Sit in on a class and **experience the interactions** between faculty and students.

2019 IMPORTANT DATES

January 28

- Spring classes start

July 1

- Attention Iowa Students! This is the last day to file the FAFSA to be eligible for the Iowa Tuition Grant (\$5,650 grant* available to students who graduated from a high school in Iowa and attend a private college in Iowa).

August 21

- Fall classes start
